This year we will be fundraising for the 2020 St. John's Summer Trip. Students will be spending three weeks in Gunjur over the summer most likely working in the Gunjur Medical Centre which supports the whole local community.

Fourth St. James's Place project trip to Gunjur.

Three groups of 10 employees and financial advisors travelled to Gunjur for a week each to work on a community project and stay with local families. These trips partnered with WasteAid who are working with MBG long term partners TARUD to tackle waste plastic and prevent it entering the oceans in this costal country. Based on an idea by students from Pewsey Vale school, through an MBG 2015 entrepreneurs project with VIBE, to melt plastic into floor and roof tiles, WasteAid has secured DFiD funding to run a two year pilot in Gunjur. Our groups were working with village volunteers and proffesionals to build a larger set of buildings on the edge of the village to increase capacity to support the whole Western District of The Gambia. If successful, the hope is to take this approach across Africa as a way of reducing plastic burning and ocean plastics.

Thank you also to those in the group who have made donations to MBG in support of TARUD, the medical centre and Disability Africa.

New Gambia charity support

We are pleased to say we have supported a new charity partner in the far SE of Gunjur village in Madina Kunkunding. The Time For Change Foundation (charity no. 1183618) is based around a group of musicians looking to support education and poverty relief through culture, sport and music. MBG has supported them to turn the area well into a bore hole with water tank, pump with solar panels and stand pipes to make water much more readily available.
